Blackjack is available in different localised versions for a more authentic experience.





UNLIMITED BLACKJACK

A key feature of Unlimited Blackjack is that an unlimited number of players can play at the same table, against the dealer.

To increase the excitement of the gameplay, Auto-Split functionality on certain pairs of player cards is built into the game rules for a unique playing experience. In Auto-Split, the player can choose to continue playing with one or two hands.

Unlimited Blackjack also includes the well-known side bets: Perfect Pairs, 21+3, Perfect 11 and Ten20.

VIP SURRENDER BLACKJACK

VIP Blackjack with Surrender provides regular Blackjack gameplay with one significant difference – the Early Surrender option. If the dealer's first dealt card is an Ace, the player can choose to surrender, and to get half of their bet returned.

Players experience a satisfying and professional gaming atmosphere that keeps them coming back for more.

HOW TO PLAY

Players take their virtual seats and try to achieve a hand that's closer to 21 than the dealer's hand, but without going over 21. The game is played with eight decks.


CARD VALUES

- Cards from 2 to 10 are worth their face value
- Face cards (Jacks, Queens and Kings) are each worth 10
- Aces are worth 1 or 11, whichever is more favourable to the hand. Note that a soft hand includes an Ace worth 11.

After the betting time has expired, the dealer deals one card face-up to each player. Dealing starts with the first player to the dealer's left and continues clockwise, ending with the dealer. The dealer then deals a second card face-up to each player but the dealer's second card is dealt face-down. The value of each player's initial hand is displayed next to their cards.

BLACKJACK

if the value of a player's initial two-card hand is exactly 21, it's a Blackjack!

INSURANCE

If the dealer's up card is an Ace, a player can choose to place an additional Insurance bet that pays out if the dealer goes on to win with Blackjack. A player clicks Yes to purchase this Insurance then places an additional bet equal to half the initial Blackjack bet.

The dealer then takes a peek at his/her face-down card to check for Blackjack. Should the dealer have Blackjack (i.e. an Ace + 10, Jack, Queen or King), the player wins twice the Insurance bet.

If the dealer does not have Blackjack, the player loses his/her Insurance bet and the game continues.

MAKING A DECISION

As soon as the player receives his/her first two cards they can make an initial decision regarding their hand to Hit, Stand, Double Down or Split.

If no decision is made before the betting time expires, a player's lack of response is interpreted as Hit in the case that the player's score is 11 or less, and Stand if it is 12 or more.

DOUBLE DOWN

If a player's first two cards total 9, 10 or 11 and a third card is likely to result in a hand that beats the dealer's hand, the player can click Double Down. This allows a player to double their main bet and receive just one more card.

HIT OR STAND

Alternatively, the player can decide to Hit to be dealt an additional card to add to the value of their hand. The player can Hit more than once to receive additional cards before they decide to Stand once they are satisfied with the value of their hand.

SPLIT

When a player's first two cards are of equal value, the player can choose to Split them into two separate hands.

If the player splits two Aces, he/she will receive just one additional card on each hand. No doubling is allowed on a Split.

SURRENDER

If a player chooses the Surrender option (in Blackjack Surrender), the player concedes his or her hand and receives half of their bet value back. A player who decides to Surrender in any given game round then takes no further part in that round.

DEALER'S HAND

The dealer must Hit (take an additional card) when his/her hand is 16 or less. The dealer must Stand on all hands of 17 or more (including a Soft 17, which is a total of 17 made up of an Ace counted as 11 and a card/s with a value of six. The dealer loses the game with a hand that exceeds 21. If a player's final hand is closer to 21 than the dealer's hand, the player wins even money on his/her initial bet.

THE GAME OUTCOME

- The player wins when the value of their final hand is closer to 21 than the dealer's hand or when the dealer busts
- If the player's hand value is the same as the dealer's hand, the game round ends in a push and the player's bet is returned
- Blackjack is only possible using the two cards in the initial two-card deal
- If the sum of the player's hand exceeds 21, the player busts and loses his/her bet on that hand.

SIDE BETS*

All our regular live Blackjack games feature Perfect Pairs, 21+3 and Lucky Ladies optional side bets. Unlimited Blackjack has two additional side bets: Perfect 11 and Ten20.

A player may place side bets in combination with their main Blackjack bet. This gives them the chance to win on any side bet whether they later win or lose on their main Blackjack bet.

PERFECT PAIRS*

Allows the player to bet on receiving any pair (e.g. two Queens, two Aces, two 7s etc) in the first two cards of his or her hand.

The level of payout depends on the probability of being dealt that pair. There are three types of winning pair combinations:

Perfect Pair	Two cards of the same suit, e.g. 2x Ace of spades	
Coloured Pair	Different suits of the same colour, e.g. 2 of Diamonds (red) and 2 of Hearts (red)	
Different suits of different colours, e.g. 6 of Clubs (black) and 6 of Hear (red).		

*An operator's fee applies to all side bets.

21+3*

Allows the player to bet on the combination of three cards: the first two cards in the player's hand and the dealer's up card.

Winning combinations (similar to Poker) are as follows, with payouts depending on the probability of the combination being dealt:

Suited Trips	Three cards of the same suit and value, e.g. 3x King of spades
Straight Flush	Suited sequence, e.g. 10, Jack and Queen of diamonds.
Three of a Kind	Three cards of the same value but different suits, e.g. any 3 Kings
Straight	In numerical sequence but different suits, e.g. 2 of diamonds, 3 of clubs, and 4 of hearts
Flush	Non-sequential cards in the same suit, e.g. 2, 6 and 10 of clubs.

*An operator's fee applies to all side bets.

LUCKY LADIES*

Allows the player to bet on the combination of the first two cards in the player's hand. The player wins a hand if the total amount of the two cards equals 20 or if one of the two cards is a Queen. In the case of the hand's total value being 21, the side bet is lost and the game continues.

Winning combinations are as follows, with payouts depending on the probability of the combination being dealt:

Lucky Ladies	The first two cards are two Queens of Hearts. This is the best possible hand for this side bet and has the biggest payout	
Matched 20	A Pair of cards of the same suit total- ling 20, e.g. A pair of Kings of Clubs; a pair of 10s of Hearts	
Suited 20	Two cards of the same suit totalling 20, e.g. a King of Clubs and a 10 of Clubs	
Any 20	Any two cards totalling 20 that do not fall in the other categories (i.e. they are not suited, pairs or contain a Queen), e.g. Ace + 9; 10 of Clubs + King of Hearts	
One Queen of Hearts	One of the first two cards is a Queen of Hearts	
One Queen	One of the first two cards is a Queen of anything but Hearts.	

*An operator's fee applies to all side bets.

Ten20*

Allows the player to bet on the combination of the first two cards in the player's hand. The player wins a hand if the total amount of the two cards equals 10 or 20.

Winning combinations are as follows, with payouts depending on the probability of the combination being dealt:

Pair of 5s	A pair of 5s of any suit, e.g. 5 of Spades + 5 of Diamonds	
Total 10	Two cards of any rank or suit that add up to 10, e.g. 4 of Diamonds + 6 of Hearts	
Total 20	Two cards of any rank or suit that add up to 20, e.g. 9 of Hearts + Ace of Clubs.	

*An operator's fee applies to all side bets.

PERFECT 11*

Allows the player to bet on the combination of the first two cards or a Blackjack in the player's hand. The player wins a hand if the total amount of the two cards equal 11 or a Blackjack.

Winning combinations are as follows, with payouts depending on the probability of the combination being dealt:

Suited 11	Two cards of the same suit that add up to 11, e.g. 8 of Spades + 3 of Spades	
Any 11	Two cards of a different suit that add up to 11, e.g. 5 of Diamonds + 6 of Hearts	
Blackjack	Two cards of any rank or suit that add up to 21, e.g. 10 of Hearts + Ace of Clubs.	

*An operator's fee applies to all side bets.


